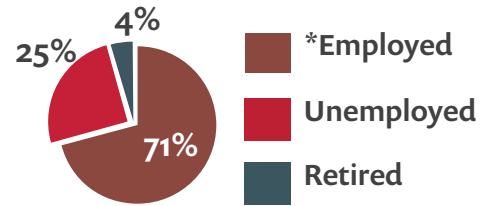


VERMILION COUNTY LABORSHED HIGHLIGHTS (2019)

- The following data provides a snapshot of the local workforce characteristics collected via laborshed survey sampling for Vermilion County.

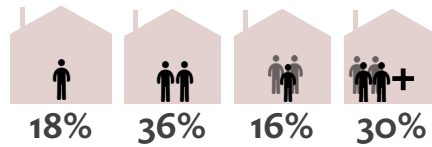

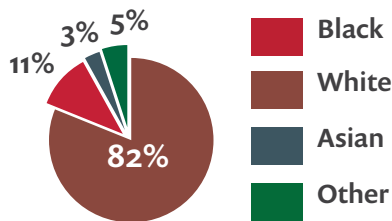

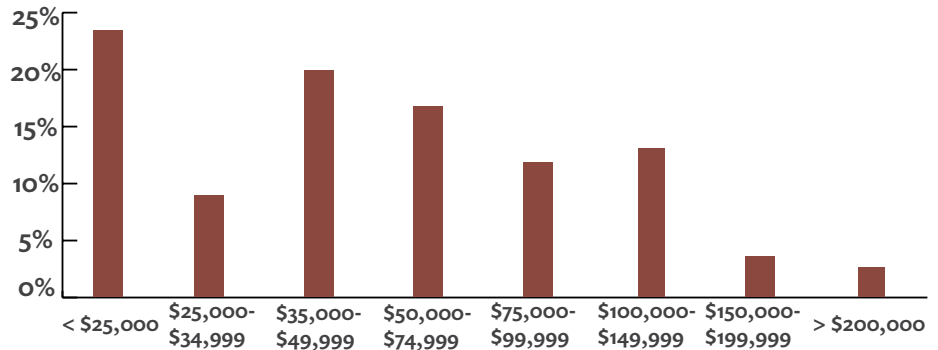

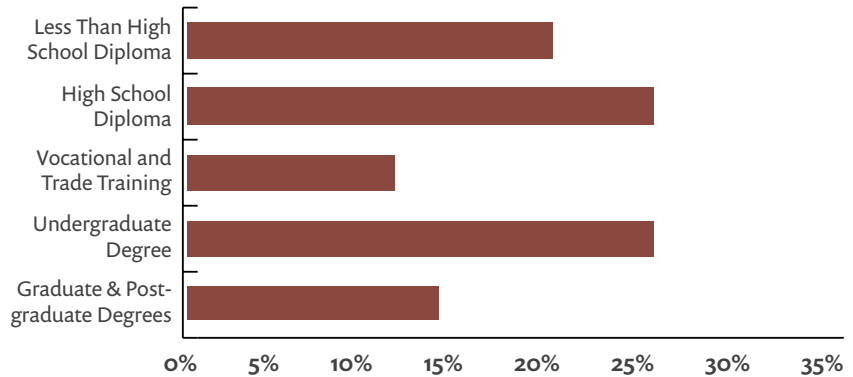

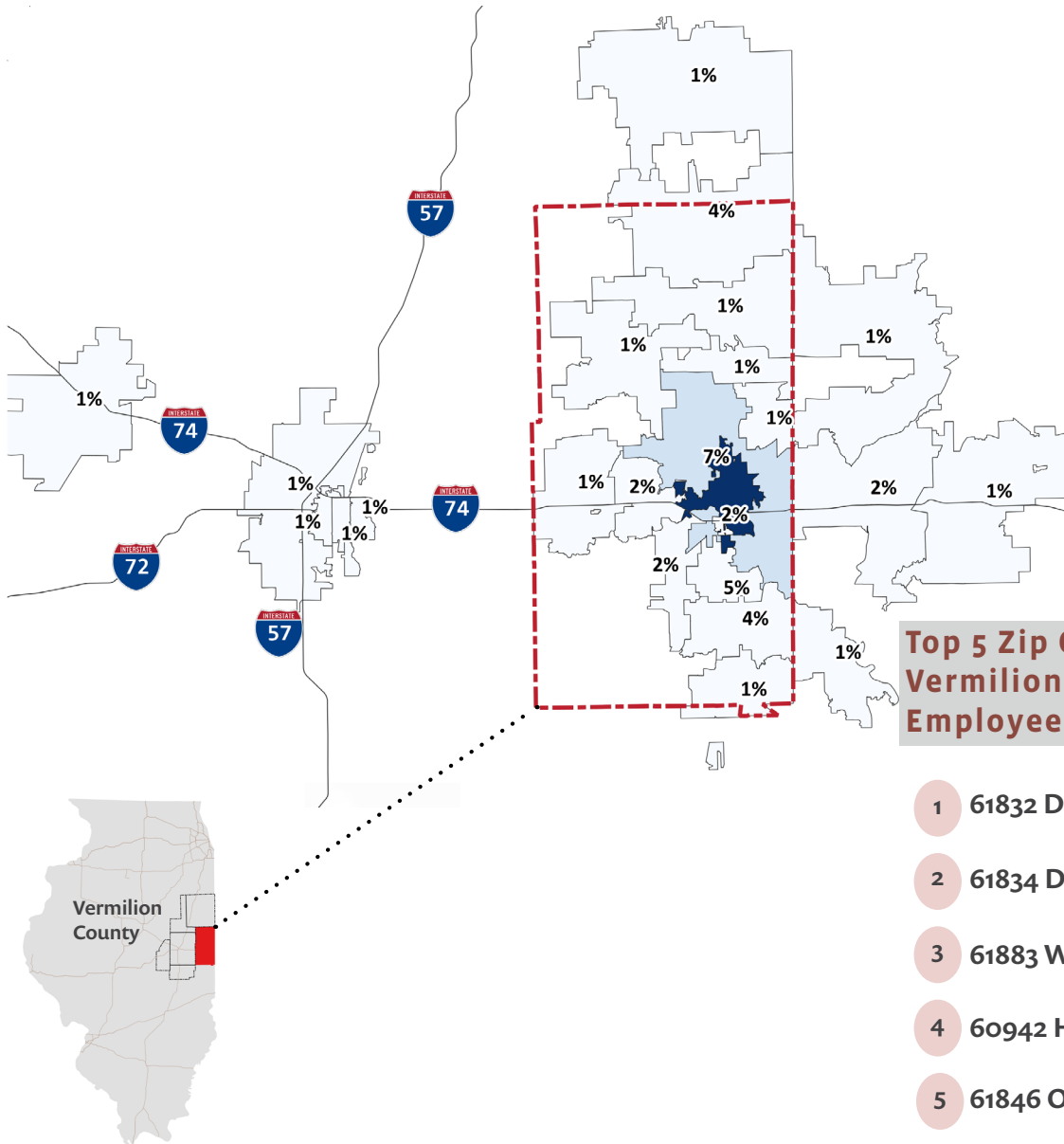
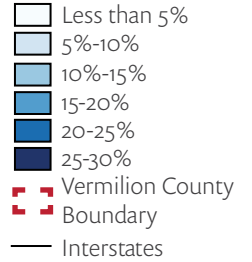

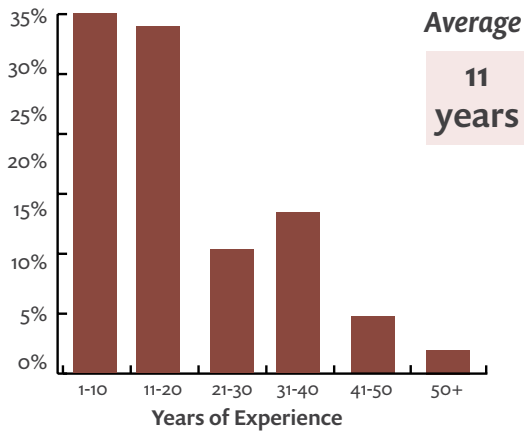

Experience in Current Field of Work

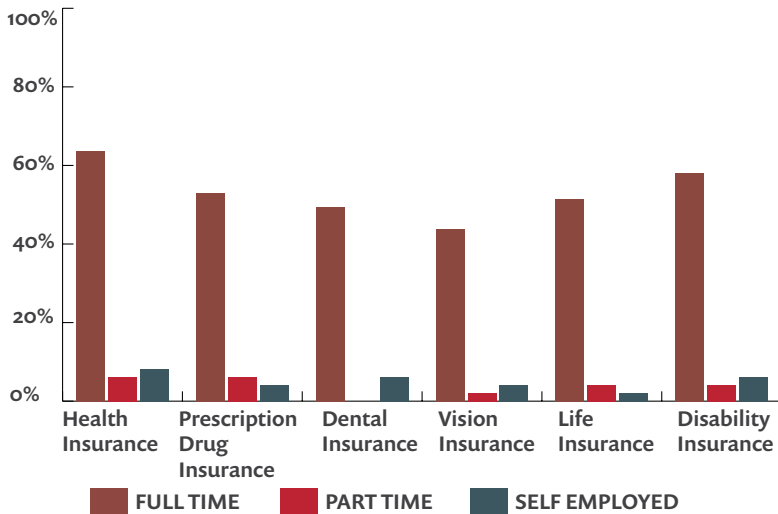

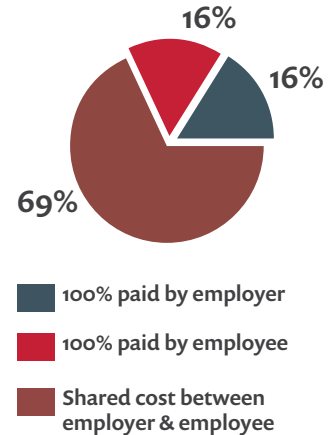
